






Are you our next Cochlear™ \$15,000 education scholarship recipient?

The Graeme Clark Scholarship, awarded by Cochlear Limited, is a unique award set up to help recipients of Cochlear™ hearing solutions who are residents of Australia and New Zealand reach their goals through university study.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Your application should include the following information:

The application form, completed and signed. Ensure all answers are typed or printed clearly. Hand and digital signatures are accepted.

A short personal statement describing your academic aspirations and other interests. This should describe your area of proposed study, your goals post-graduation and the reasons why you wish to be a Graeme Clark Scholar. This statement must not exceed 1000 words and should be written in a simple and direct manner. You must sign the statement; digital and hand signatures are accepted.

Final school academic results (attach copy).

Prior university academic transcripts (if available).

Your university admissions notice (if available).

A succinct list of the principle activities and awards in school (including prizes, scholarships, offices held, athletic record and extracurricular activities) with dates. This summary must not exceed one A4 page in length, and should be set in a typeface no smaller than 10 points.

One photocopy of your birth certificate, passport or other proof of age and citizenship.

Proof of residency e.g. driver's license.

Three letters of reference. The referees should notbe directly related to you, and preferably haveknown you for at least two years. At least tworeferees must be individuals from whom you have received educational instructions.

Please keep in mind your application will be evaluated on your academic achievements, extracurricular activities, community involvement and leadership skills. The overall quality of your application will also be judged. If you have further enquiries please email: customerservice@cochlear.com
