ACTIVITY: My Top 5

Take a card and discuss My Top 5. Compare your top 5 with your partner's. Are any the same? Which are different? Topics include:

sports I like, ways of going to school, things I would take with me to the moon, places I would go on holiday, insects, things to do in the dark, birthday presents, sandwich fillings, pizza toppings

ACTIVITY: Shout It Out

- You need post card sized cards with the category and 10 items printed on them.
- The person with the card tells the group the category.
- The group must shout out as many items in that category as they can.
- The card holder ticks off the ones shouted out which are on their card.
- You stop after 1 minute or sooner if all 10 have been guessed.
- The winners are the team with the most items ticked off on the cards after 15 minutes or after four cards each.

Topics on the cards include:

- » Kitchen utensils
- » Picnic things
- » Forms of transport
- » Items in your bedroom
- » Things in the garden
- » Actions to show movement
- » Blank cards for your child to write down their choices of items for others to guess e.g. people who help us, things found at the park

ACTIVITY: One Word at a Time (probably for slightly older children)

The adult holds a card above the child's head from behind. The others in the group must say one word each to help the child guess what the word is. How many words can be guessed in 3 minutes? You can keep the same child guessing for the whole 3 minutes or quickly change the child with the next person each time a word is guessed.

Example: Garden

- E.g. Lawn Mower: cutting grass
- E.g. Hose Pipe: water (Guess: watering can NO) for cleaning car (bucket NO) tube
- E.g. Snails: slug with shell
- E.g. Hockey: hit small ball stick

Write your own cards around topics on scrap paper. This is a good way of introducing words which may be coming up over the next month. Use words which you use as a family, have a variety of known and new words. Think broadly!

Topics on the cards include:

- » Christmas
- » Vacation Trip
- » Camping
- » Garden
- » Water sports
- » Sport

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
