L7510	Repair of prosthetic device, repair or replace minor parts
L7520	Repair Prosthetic Device, labor component, per 15 minutes
L8614	Cochlear device, includes all internal and external components*
L8617	Transmitting coil for use with cochlear implant device, replacement
L8618	Transmitter cable for use with cochlear implant device or auditory osseointegrated device, replacement
L8619	Cochlear implant external speech processor, replacement
L8621	Zinc air battery for use with cochlear implant device and auditory osseointegrated sound processors, replacement, each
L8622	Alkaline battery for use with cochlear implant device, any size, replacement, each
L8623	Lithium ion battery for use with cochlear implant device speech processor, worn on the body, other than ear level, replacement, each
L8624	Lithium ion battery for use with cochlear implant or auditory osseointegrated device speech processor, ear level, replacement, each

L8625	External recharging system for battery for use with cochlear implant or auditory osseointegrated device, replacement only, each**
L8629	Transmitting coil and cable, integrated for use with cochlear implant device, replacement
L8690	Auditory osseointegrated device, includes all internal and external components*
L8691	Auditory osseointegrated device, external sound processor, excludes transducer/actuator, replacement only, each†
L8692	Auditory osseointegrated device, external sound processor, used without osseointegration, body worn, includes headband or other means of external attachment (<i>not covered by Medicare</i>)
L8693	Auditory osseointegrated device abutment, any length, replacement only
L8694	Auditory osseointegrated device, transducer/actuator, replacement only, each†
L8699	Prosthetic implant, not otherwise specified
L9900	Orthotic and prosthetic supply, accessory, and/or service component of another HCPCS "L" code

* These codes are billed as kits, all of the internal and external components are billed together using these billing codes. These components must not be unbundled for billing purposes.

** L9900 may be utilized to report individual components of the recharging system if they are replaced separately

† Changes to the 2018 HCPCS code set unbundle the two components of an auditory osseointegrated implant external sound processor into two codes, one for the sound processor and one for the actuator/transducer, requiring both codes to be billed when reporting replacement of a complete external sound processor system. The two codes may also be used independently when reporting only one component of a sound processor system (e.g. report only L8694 to report replacement of the actuator component of a Baha® 5 SuperPower).
