Supporting document checklist

Please make sure the following information is included with your application:

- The completed application form signed in ink.
- Copy of your final or predicted school or college Statement of Results (please include general and/or advanced level results).
- A succinct list of academic and extra-curricular activities or awards (including dates and not exceeding one page in length).
- A personal statement supporting your application. You should describe, using simple and direct language, how a cochlear implant has opened up more opportunities to you in the hearing world, the area of proposed study, your aspirations and reasons why you wish to be considered for the Cochlear UK & Ireland Anders Tjellström Scholarship. This statement should be typed and must not exceed 1,000 words.
- Two letters of reference. The referees should not be directly related to you and preferably have known you for at least two years. (At least one of these must be an individual from whom you have received educational instruction).

Winning the scholarship is contingent on the applicant being able to provide proof of UK or Ireland residency and a copy of study acceptance letter. If the winner is unable to provide copies of these documents, Cochlear reserve the right to select an alternative winner.

Applicants must submit their completed application form with all supporting documentation and required information by the deadline. No late applications or parts of the application packet will be accepted.

The amount payable under the terms of the award is the total amount payable and any liability for any tax is the responsibility of the recipient of the award.
